

Capacity Development Workshop

Alignment between Curriculum, Teaching and Assessment

18 - 20 May 2015, Seoul, Republic of Korea

Objective

The Network on Education Quality Monitoring in the Asia-Pacific (NEQMAP) Secretariat at UNESCO Bangkok, in collaboration with the Korea Institute for Curriculum and Evaluation (KICE), is organizing its third capacity development workshop on 18-20 May 2015 in Seoul, Republic of Korea. The workshop is also supported by the Global Partnership for Education (GPE) and the Malaysian Fund-in-Trust (MFIT).

Drawing from KICE's expertise of curriculum and evaluation and conjoining with NEQMAP's activities, this workshop will focus on an overview of alignment issues between curriculum, teaching and assessment, covering parameters of what, why and how. The main target audience shall be government officials who are deeply involved in or familiar with development of national curriculum and/or assessment in their respective countries.

Venue and Date

Day 1 of the workshop, which is a side event of World Education Forum, will be held at Songdo Convensia Center in Incheon on 18 May while Day 2 and 3 of the workshop will be held at [Ramada Seoul Dongdaemun Hotel](#) on 19-20 May 2015 in Seoul, Republic of Korea. Participants are expected to stay for the full duration of the course and attend all sessions.
